Leanna Skarnulis will demo for us how to turn the Confetti Cane into her version of a Bluebonnet Cane and will use this cane to make a clock.

Leanna will demonstrate the simple and versatile Confetti Cane by Donna Concha. See tutorial <http://www.polymerclaycentral.com/confetticane.html>

For the clock, I adapted the confetti cane to simulate a bluebonnet field, which is what I'll demo. Then I'll show how to assemble a clock, using the 3/8" Walnut Hollow clock movement. ■

Bring these supplies to make a cane at the meeting:

- ◆ Kato Polyclay-translucent—enough to make 2 2.5" squares rolled at #2 on the Atlas pasta machine.
- ◆ Small amounts of 3-6 colors. For bluebonnets, I used green and cobalt blue and smaller amounts of the blue lightened with lavender and darkened with purple. Because I wanted the colors to spread when the cane slices are applied, I added several drops of diluent to the colors.
- ◆ Blade
- ◆ Brayer
- ◆ Work-surface ■
